Curriculum

'Learning Talk'

Every two weeks we will be asking families to participate in 'Learning Talks' with their children.

By discussing topics and ideas prior to learning, you will help your children get ahead in their personal learning. Students will follow up in class with activities that are related to their 'Learning Talks'.

Foundation

In Maths this week we will be focussing on ordinal number eg. 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. The following week we will be looking at the duration of time for different activities we do during the day. For example brushing our teeth takes a short time whereas sleeping takes a long time.

Junior

In Maths the Juniors are focusing on money. Students are ordering coins, notes and collections of coins and notes based on their value. You can support your child's learning by involving them in the shopping and comparing the price of items that you buy, talking about what is worth more or less.

Multiplication

Middle

In Maths we have been focusing on measurement with a main focus on Volume and Capacity. Next we are focusing on Place Value. We will be looking at how to partition, rearrange and re-group numbers up to and above tens of thousands.

Senior

In Maths we have had a strong focus on multiplication. We will be working on numbers to the power of ten and double and triple digit multiplication. Please work with your child on their automatic recall of all their timetables up to 10x10. We will also be working on interpreting and representing data in a variety of different graphs.

Explanation Writing

Tells or explores how things work or how they came to be

Includes

Statement

Write what is going to be explained

Explanation Sequence

Present a series of events that relate to time, or cause, or both. You might include a diagram or flow charts, which you will need to comment on.

Concluding Statement

(Optional) You may like to include an evaluation or interesting comments on what you have explained.
