# Curriculum

## 'Learning Talk'

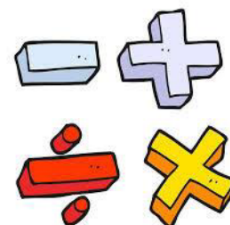
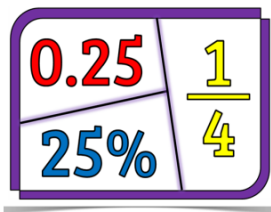
Every two weeks we will be asking families to participate in 'Learning Talks' with their children. By discussing topics and ideas prior to learning, you will help your children get ahead in their personal learning. Students will follow up in class with activities that are related to their 'Learning Talks'.

### Foundation -

In Numeracy, students will be working on sharing and fractions. Provide your child with opportunities to share objects such as toys or food between their siblings or groups. When cutting food such as apples, sandwiches, pizza etc. discuss the fraction that has been made.

### Junior -

In the Juniors this week we are learning about money. To support your child's learning at school you could encourage and support them to recognise the difference between coins as well as recognising which are cents and dollars. You could also help them to count collections of money such as the money in their money box!



### Middle -

In numeracy middle students will be working with the four operations; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Have discussions about how addition, subtraction, multiplication and division can be used in everyday situations. Also have your child practice their multiplication facts (Times Tables) so they develop automatic recall.

### Senior -

In numeracy, students are working with fractions, decimals and percentages, and linking these to the probability of an event occurring. Have discussion with your child about fractions/percentages of a quantity, eg.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of 20 or 25% of 50. When shopping or cooking involve your child in working out quantities of ingredients or discounts off purchases.

## Discussion Writing

During discussion writing, the author writes what the issue is and states that different groups can have different opinions. Points and views for and against are included, you could help your child by discussing points of view at home. Discussion texts include a summary or a recommendation so ask your child to revise what you have talked about and to give their recommendation explaining why.

### SEAL ROCKS BOAT CRUISE

On Tuesday 20th November, the Environment Ambassadors were given the opportunity to attend a boat cruise to Seal Rocks at Phillip Island.

The colony currently has approximately 30,000 seals. However, the number of pups being born in recent years has declined. Research is showing that this is due to poor health of the mother seals. The main contributor to this is plastic in the ocean. The mother seals consume the plastic, thinking it is food. They become sick and are unable to conceive the pups or carry them to full term.

We must all be responsible with plastics and make sure we dispose of them in the appropriate way so they don't end up polluting our oceans and waterways. By doing this, hopefully the seal population will start to increase again!

## Language Support Program

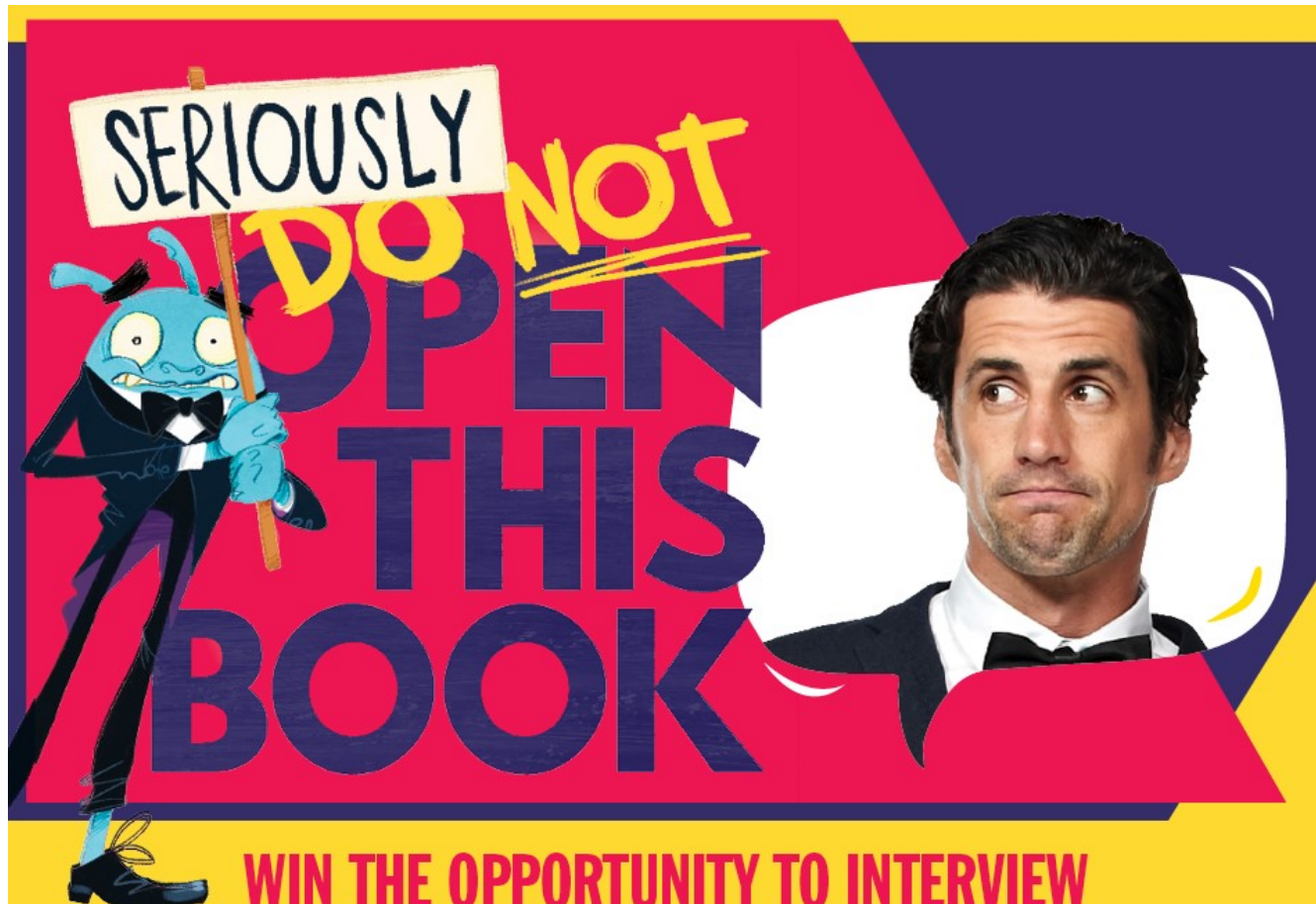


It has been a creative time in the Language Program these past two weeks. Our Language Experiences were both engaging and fun – smiles from all.

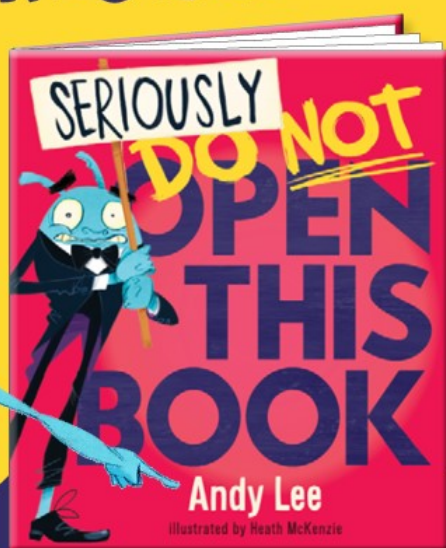

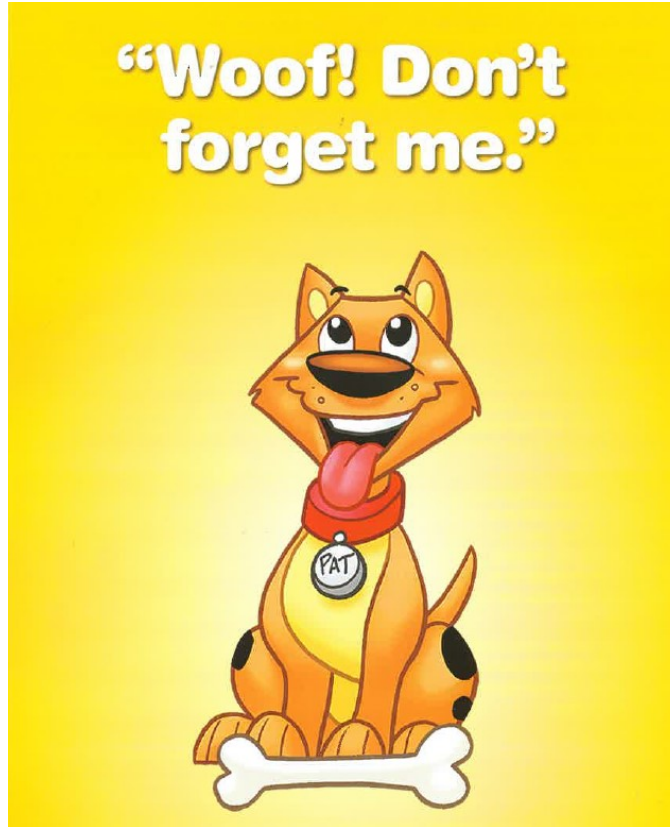
